



## TROPICAL CYCLONE ADVISORY #1 FOR: Tropical Depression

**ISSUED AT 5:00 PM, 27 October 2020**

(Valid for broadcast until the next advisory to be issued at 11 AM Tomorrow)

**THE LOW PRESSURE AREA EAST OF SOUTHERN LUZON HAS DEVELOPED INTO A TROPICAL DEPRESSION.**

<b>Friday afternoon</b> 30 October 2020	<b>1,030 km East of Southern Luzon (15.4°N, 131.2°E)</b> Tropical Storm
<b>Saturday afternoon</b> 31 October 2020	<b>315 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (14.0°N, 127.1°E)</b> Severe Tropical Storm
<b>Sunday afternoon</b> 01 November 2020	<b>135 km West of Legazpi City, Albay (13.3°N, 122.5°E)</b> Severe Tropical Storm

**Track and intensity outlook:**

- The Tropical Depression will move northwestward or west-northwestward today through Thursday, then southwestward by Friday towards Bicol Region-Eastern Visayas area. On the forecast track, it may enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) tomorrow evening or Thursday.
- The Low Pressure Area outside the PAR developed into a Tropical Depression at 8:00 AM today. It is forecast to intensify into tropical storm category in the next 72 hours.

**Hazards affecting land and coastal waters:**

- This disturbance is not affecting the weather over any portion of the country at this time.

**Other information:**

- Once inside the PAR, the Tropical Depression will be given local name "ROLLY".

**The public and the disaster risk reduction and management council concerned are advised to monitor for the next update on this weather disturbance to be incorporated in the Public Weather Forecast at 4 AM tomorrow and in the next advisory at 11 AM Tomorrow.**

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
